- **Winter/Spring Festival**

- The council discussed the feasibility of a Winter Festival, noting the significant amount of work required and the conflict with the upcoming Casino event.
- **Decision:** It was agreed to postpone the festival and explore a **Spring Festival (April/May)** instead. This allows for better weather for outdoor activities and can be used as an incentive for Casino volunteer recruitment.
- **Action Item:** A motion was passed to explore a Spring Festival, and a planning committee will be formed after the holiday season. The event will be used to encourage Casino volunteer sign-ups, offering free family admission to those who volunteer. The secretary will send out communication soon.
- **Suggestion:** Instead of a hired vendor like previous years, the council considered purchasing a barbecue grill for future self-catered events on the school patio.

- **Shrove Tuesday**

- The traditional Shrove Tuesday breakfast was discussed, noting the increasing cost and requirements from previous sponsor, Denny's.
- **Action Item:** The council will contact Denny's to inquire about a potential discounted rate or explore other options, such as purchasing pancakes in bulk or making them in-house, to keep costs reasonable and reduce family fees. The sausages were very popular and will be kept, while the juice boxes will be removed due to the associated waste and sugar.

- **Staffing Update:** Mrs. Pugh is leaving for a position in ECSD HR and will be missed. Mrs. Trojanowicz will return from maternity leave to take over a class.
- **Budget Update:** The school is currently facing a **\$50,000 operating deficit**.
- **PAT Results:** The school had excellent results for English Language Arts and Social Studies, significantly above the provincial average for both acceptable standard and excellence. Math results were challenging, with the acceptable standard score being only 38% provincially.
- **Upcoming Events:**
